Тема: "Новорічні свята"

Вид уроку: комбінований

Хід уроку.

1-ведучий:

Різдво це відоме родинне свято у Великій Британії. Його празднують 25 грудня. Санта Клаус одержав таке ім'я від людини відомої як Святий Ніколас який робив пожертвування бідним та діткам.

Санта Клаусом в різних місцях світу називали по-різному, в Іспанії Санта Бальтазаро, італійці називали Ла Бельфана, в Данії Джула Ниссен, на Німеччині Занкт Герр, а в Україні Дід Мороз.

В1: Діти в Англії проводили театральні вистави. Давайте і ми спробуємо. Ми покажемо театральну виставу "Three little kittens"

Author: Three little kittens lost their mittens and they began to cry.

The 1st kitten: Oh, Mother dear!

The 2nd kitten: We very much fear!

The 3rd kitten (crying): That we have lost our mittens!

Mother Cat: What? Lost your mittens, you are naughty kittens! Then you will have no pie!

Mieeow, mieeow! No pie! (Three kittens look for their mittens)

Author: Three little kittens found their mittens and they began to cry

The 1st kitten: Oh, Mother dear!

The 2nd kitten: See here, see here!

The 3rd kitten: We have found our mittens!

Mother Cat: You are good kittens! Put on your mittens! And you will have some pie!
